

**RESOLUTION OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF NEW  
MEXICO ON UNITY, INTERNAL DISCIPLINE, AND  
CONSTRUCTIVE GOVERNANCE**

**WHEREAS, the Republican Party of New Mexico exists to advance conservative principles, elect Republicans to office, and serve the citizens of New Mexico through effective, principled leadership; and**

**WHEREAS unity, mutual respect, and disciplined communication are essential to maintaining the credibility, effectiveness, and long-term success of the Party; and**

**WHEREAS, internal disagreements are inevitable within any broad political organization, but unresolved conflict, public outbursts, and unstructured communication undermine trust, morale, and electoral outcomes; and**

**WHEREAS, responsible leadership requires addressing concerns through established channels, with the intent to resolve issues rather than amplify them; and**

**WHEREAS exaggeration of internal disputes and public airing of grievances—particularly through social media or other public forums—damages the Party, distracts from its mission, and benefits political opponents; and**

**WHEREAS the Republican Party of New Mexico recognizes the importance of order, accountability, and a clear chain of command in organizational decision-making and conflict resolution;**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Republican Party of New Mexico affirms unity as a core operational principle and expects all officers, county parties, committees, candidates, and affiliated members to act in a manner that strengthens—not weakens—the Party as a whole; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that concerns, disputes, or grievances shall first be addressed through internal, established channels of communication and leadership, respecting the Party’s chain of command, before any public commentary is made; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that members are encouraged to seek resolution of issues through direct dialogue, mediation, and problem-solving, with the goal of correction and improvement rather than accusation or escalation; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that public communications by Party officers and representatives shall be measured, factual, and purposeful, avoiding emotional outbursts, inflammatory language, or exaggeration that may misrepresent internal matters or damage Party integrity; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that social media and public platforms shall not be used to bypass leadership, apply pressure through public outrage, or litigate internal Party matters that are more appropriately handled within Party structure; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that leadership at all levels shall model discipline, restraint, professionalism, and respect, setting the standard for conduct throughout the Party; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect unless and until it is amended or rescinded by proper authority of the Republican Party of New Mexico in accordance with Party rules.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution was duly considered and **adopted by vote of the State Central Committee of the Republican Party of New Mexico**, convened in Ruidoso, New Mexico on March 7, 2026, and shall take effect immediately upon adoption, remaining in full force and effect unless and until amended or rescinded in accordance with Party rules.
